<b>12 Photography</b>	<b>1</b>	<p><b>EXPERIMENTAL IMAGERY</b></p> <p>As an introduction to the course pupils will embark on a diverse journey exploring technical skills, processes and camera usage. Special attention will be focussed on investigating the formal elements. Pupils will research and analyse the work of contemporary and past practitioners to inform understanding and own photographic process. Pupils will learn and develop how to critically analyse the work of others to inform and influence own practice. 	<b>2/3</b>	<p><b>PERSONAL INVESTIGATION</b></p> <p>In collaboration with the teacher pupils will select a theme for their personal investigation. Pupils will undertake an in-depth journey of photographic exploration into the set theme. Pupils will research and analyse the work of contemporary and past practitioners to inform understanding and own photographic process. Pupils will draw from previous experiments, skills and knowledge and build on them responding to personal line of enquiry. Techniques are further demonstrated throughout the personal investigation to further enhance students' practical skill and understanding.
