13 Photography	1	<p>PERSONAL INVESTIGATION In collaboration with the teacher pupils will select a theme for their personal investigation. Pupils will undertake an in-depth journey of photographic exploration into the set theme. Pupils will research and analyse the work of contemporary and past practitioners to inform understanding and own photographic process. Pupils will draw from previous experiments, skills, media and knowledge to build on responding to personal line of enquiry. Techniques are further demonstrated throughout the personal investigation to further enhance students' practical skill and understanding.
