12	1	<p><u>Topic: Edward VI and Mary I, 1547-1558</u></p> <p>Lessons Include: Edward VI, Duke of Somerset, Lady Jane Grey, Mary I, Persecution of Protestants, Protests under Edward and Mary</p>	<p><u>Assessment Skill Focus: Source Analysis – 30 mark essay (AO2)</u></p> <p>Students <u>analyse</u> sources to make <u>inferences</u> from them. They will also test the utility of sources and make <u>judgements</u> in order to fully <u>evaluate</u> them.</p>
	2	<p><u>Topic: Elizabeth I and Religion, Elizabeth I and Politics, 1558-88</u></p> <p>Lessons Include: Religious problems and Settlement, The Puritans, the Catholic Challenge, Mary Queen of Scots, The Privy Council, Gender, Marriage</p>	<p><u>Assessment Skill Focus: Essay Writing – 20 mark essay (AO1)</u></p> <p>Students <u>describe</u>, <u>analyse</u> and <u>evaluate</u> key features and make substantiated <u>judgements</u>.</p>
	3	<p><u>Topic: Unit 1 – Elizabeth I and Economic Problems. Elizabeth I and her Later Years, 1588-1603</u></p> <p>Lessons Include: Debt, Overseas Trade, Francis Drake, Poverty, the Spanish Armada, Rebellion in Ireland, Reputation</p>	<p><u>Assessment Skill Focus: Essay Writing – 20 mark essay (AO1)</u></p> <p>Students <u>describe</u>, <u>analyse</u> and <u>evaluate</u> key features and make substantiated <u>judgements</u>.</p> <p>They will also recap skills from the previous unit (AO2).</p>

12	1	<p><u>Topic: The establishment and development of the Weimar Republic: 1919 - Jan 1933.</u> Lessons Include: The Treaty of Versailles, the Weimar Constitution, Challenges to Weimar, Stresemann’s foreign policy and the ‘golden years of Weimar’</p> <p><u>Topic: The establishment of the Nazi Dictatorship and its domestic policies: Feb 1933 - 1939.</u> Lessons Include: <i>Gleichschaltung</i>, Night of the Long Knives, censorship and police state.</p>	<p><u>Assessment Skill Focus: Analyse the significance of an event – 10 mark essay (AO1)</u></p> <p>Students <u>analyse</u> two events and make a judgement of which event was the most significant to the time period.</p>
	2	<p><u>Topic: The impact of war and defeat on Germany: 1939 - 1949</u></p> <p>Lessons Include: War economy, Total War, living standards, Cold War and Bizonia.</p>	<p><u>Assessment Skill Focus: Essay Writing – 20 mark essay (AO1)</u></p> <p>Students <u>describe</u>, <u>analyse</u> and <u>evaluate</u> key features and make substantiated <u>judgements</u>.</p>

	3	<p><u>Topic: Divided Germany: The Federal Republic and the DDR, 1949 – 1963</u></p> <p>Lessons include: The Basic Law, life in the FRG, life in the GDR and the Berlin Wall.</p>	<p><u>Assessment Skill Focus: Essay Writing – 20 mark essay (AO1)</u></p> <p>Students <u>describe</u>, <u>analyse</u> and <u>evaluate</u> key features and make substantiated <u>judgements</u>.</p>
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
